

RESOLUTION #1, 2006  
Town of Moffat  
February 7, 2006

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat wished to retain the moneys raised from all sources, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat has lowered the mil levy each year to comply with state laws, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat wished to apply for grants in the future, requiring evidence of ability to pay the matching funds from revenue, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat wishes to retain and spend moneys from all income,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved to place the following issue on the ballot for the General Election on April 4, 2006:


REVENUE LIMITS

SHALL THE TOWN OF MOFFAT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND ALL REVENUE AND OTHER FUNDS RECEIVED FROM ANY SOURCE, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE TOWN'S PROPERTY TAX REVENUES GENERATED FROM THE MILL LEVY, COMMENCING AS OF JANUARY 1, 2006 AND CONTINUING ANNUALLY THEREAFTER UNTIL REPEALED, AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, OFFSET AND EXCEPTION TO THE UNITS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE APPLY UNDER, AND WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RASING OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW, AND AS A PERMANENT WAIVER OF THE 5.5% LIMITATION UNDER SECTION 20-1-301, C.R.S.?


