

Resolution Number 07

**A RESOLUTION REFERRING A TABOR TAX ELECTION TO THE ELECTORATE OF THE
TOWN OF MOFFAT, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat currently imposes a sales tax of 2% on the sale of tangible personal property within the Town of Moffat; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-2-105 the Town of Moffat has the authority to also levy a sales tax on retail sales of food items; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Moffat currently does not levy a sales tax on these food items;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Moffat:

That pursuant to Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution the following tax question is hereby referred to the Town of Moffat electorate for its regularly scheduled April 2008 municipal election:

SHALL THE TOWN OF MOFFAT TAXES BE INCREASED BY \$7200 IN THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR AND BY WHATEVER AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY IN EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, SHALL AN ORDINANCE BE APPROVED, SUCH ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE TOWN'S SALES TAX TO INCLUDE RETAIL SALES OF FOOD, SUCH CHANGE TO TAKE EFFECT AFTER PASSAGE OF THE ORDINANCE, AND SHALL A REVENUE CHANGE IN EVERY YEAR CAUSED BY SUCH EXTENSION OF THE SALES TAX BE APPROVED, PERMITTING ALL OF THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH EXTENSION OF THE TOWN'S SALES TAX TO BE COLLECTED AND SPENT IN ANY YEAR WITHOUT LIMITATION OR CONDITION AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE COLLECTION AND SPENDING OF ANY OTHER REVENUES OR FUNDS BY THE TOWN UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?




