**A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING REGISTRATION AND USE OF 9-1-1 EMERGENCY
NOTIFICATION SYSTEM**

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montrose, Ouray, San Miguel and Saguache Counties and the municipalities therein have seen a significant increase in the use of cell phones by residents and businesses in their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, a majority of all homes in the United States use cell phones or internet-based phones as the primary form of communication, and many such homes do not have land or wired lines; and

WHEREAS, the Montrose Emergency Telephone Service Authority (“METSA”) entered into a Services Agreement to provide high speed 9-1-1 emergency notifications to geographically selected calling areas within Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montrose, Ouray, San Miguel and Saguache Counties for wireless users; and


WHEREAS, early notification to residents during an emergency significantly reduces the likelihood of injuries and loss of life; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide efficient and effective warning systems, METSA is recommending that all residents and businesses in the seven-county region be encouraged to add their phones and geographic locations to a 9-1-1 Emergency Notification System via the following Website: <http://www.westregion.org>.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Moffat, State of Colorado, hereby supports the efforts of the Montrose Emergency Telephone Service Authority to encourage residents and businesses to register their phones with the 9-1-1 Emergency Notification System.
